Newly Updated Curriculum

This newly updated is intended for all prescribers of ER/LA opioids including: pain specialists, primary care physicians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, advanced practice nurses, dentists, addiction medicine physicians, psychiatrists and other physicians and clinicians.

Learning Objectives

- Accurately assess patients with pain for consideration of an opioid trial.
- Establish realistic goals for pain management and restoration of function.
- Initiate opioid treatment (IR and ER/LA) safely and judiciously
- Monitor and re-evaluate treatment continuously; discontinue safely when appropriate.
- Counsel patients and caregivers about use, misuse, abuse, diversion, and overdose.

Sexual Harassment Learning Objectives:

- 1. Identify behaviors that may constitute sexual harassment
- 2. Define the role of a supervisor in combatting harassment.
- 3. List the steps to take if a harassment complaint is made.
- 4. Discuss possible remedies for a patient who is acting inappropriately.
